Ask ss to ask and answer What is your favorite meal in pairs. Ask ss to tell the class about their partner, e.g. Ahmad's favorite meal is lamb and rice.</p> <p>Ask ss to describe picture 1. Say Listen. Play the 1<sup>st</sup> dialogue while ss point to the 1<sup>st</sup> picture and ask: what's she having? Play the rest of the recording while ss listen and point to the correct picture. Play it again and ask ss to describe the pictures.</p> <p>Ask ss to tell what the ppl are doing in each picture. Say NOW listen and say Yes or No. Play the recording , pause for ss to give answer. Ask ss to say what they can see in pairs. End by asking the class to tell different fruit and vegetables they know.</p>	<p>Ask and answer questions</p> <p>Check answers</p>
