Many (Negative form and questions) countable اشياء تعد – تاتى في السؤال والنفي How many shops in this area? There aren't many shops in this area.

Much (Negative form and questions) (uncountable) أشياء لا تعد – تاتى في السؤال والنفي How much time do you have? I don't have much time, so please be quick.

A lot of - lots of (positive form) كثير من مع الاشياء التي تعد او لا تعد There are a lot of people at my office. Lots of people are at my office.

A few (countable) اشياء تعد There are a few books in my bag. A little (uncountable) أشياء لا تعد There is a little juice in this glass.

SHOULD/SHOULDN'T

We use should and shouldn't to give advice or to talk about what we think is right or wrong.

(يجلب) Infinitive الفعل في المصدر + Should

- It's late. You should go to bed.
- We should speak politely to our teachers.

(لا يجلب) Infinitive الفعل في المصدر + Shouldn't

- You shouldn't be rude to your parents.
- We shouldn't eat too many sweets.

(Condition) (The consequence)



If I go to the mall, I will buy a CD. (We use comma between the 2 sentences)
I will buy a CD if I go to the mall (we don't use comma)

Examples:

- I will read the book if you give it to me.
- The children will be happy if Grandma comes to see us.
- If the weather is hot tomorrow, we will go the beach.

<u>If + Present in negative form (don't/doesn't + Infinitive)</u>, (will, shall, can, may) + Infinitive.

If it doesn't rain, I will play football with my friends.

If we don't go outside, we may study math.

 - -Few cars, friends, books
- Little you will use with uncountable, singular nouns.
 - -Little money, time, energy

- When do we use present perfect tense?
- 1. Things that were completed a short time ago.
- e.g. Razi has brushed her teeth.
- 2. An action which started in the past and has continued up to now.

Examples:

- Look! A tree has fallen across the road
- Look! Mum has washed my jeans.
- Samy has cleaned his shoes.
- The children have eaten all the cake.


